The Murrysville Community Library invites you to join us for our 2022 Summer Reading Children's Program: Oceans of Possibilities!



### **How to Register:**

Starting June 13th, sign up using the Beanstack app or website to track your reading at <u>murrysville.beanstack.org</u>. Along the way, you'll receive virtual badges and earn chances to win fun prizes!

After registering, children and families participating in the **Preschool and/or School Age Beanstack Challenges (ages 0-12 years old)** can pick up a registration bag. In your bag, you'll find a print reading log to use alongside Beanstack and all the supplies you need to complete many of the Beanstack challenges.

### **How it Works:**

- 1. Set a reading goal for the summer and log your reading on Beanstack.
  - ⇒ Ocean Explorers, children who are not yet reading, are encouraged to have their grown-ups read to them for at least 4 hours throughout the summer—that's just about 5 minutes a day, or a picture book a day.
  - ⇒ Seafaring Adventurers, children who have started school and are independently reading, are encouraged to track 12 hours of reading this summer while school is out—that's just about 10 minutes a day, or a chapter a day.
  - ⇒ Treasure Hunters, middle schoolers and teens, are encouraged to track at least 9 hours of reading.

### 2. Complete activities through Beanstack.

⇒ Follow along on Beanstack to complete additional activities that will earn you raffle tickets for prize drawings, like Pittsburgh Zoo tickets, gift certificates, and more. **Deadline to enter tickets is August 3rd.** 

### 3. Visit the library for in-person programs and events.
