To Murrysville Community Library Patrons, Community Members, and Friends:

We are excited to announce that beginning on August 3<sup>rd</sup> patrons can begin scheduling appointments to visit the library. We know how much you have missed browsing for books and we have missed seeing you too!

Half hour appointments will be offered Monday-Saturday between the hours of 12-3pm. Please call the library at 724-327-1102 to schedule your appointment. We have been busy working behind the scenes cataloging and processing plenty of new and exciting titles to peruse. Don't forget to bring your library card!

The public computers will also be available during your 30 minute appointment if you are in need of printing, copying or internet services. Computers will be sanitized between uses. Public headphones will not be available. If you need sound, please bring your own headphones/earbuds. If you do not have your own, the Library has a supply of disposable earbuds for purchase. The price is \$2.00 and are yours to keep.

Concerned about entering public spaces or enjoying having your items brought out to your car? Don't worry, curbside service will continue to be offered for the foreseeable future. Curbside hours are 12-3pm, Monday through Saturday. Please use the online catalog or call the library to request a title. We will call you when it is ready and schedule a curbside appointment.

If you need to return an item, please use the outside book drop. If you are returning a Wonderbook or Launchpad, please call the library and schedule a drop off. For your safety, all returned items are quarantined for 72 hours before returning to circulation.

The health of our patrons and staff is of the utmost importance to us. With that in mind, all individuals entering the Library must wear a face covering that covers the individual's mouth and nose unless they have a medical condition that impedes their ability to wear a face covering. Children two years of age and under are not required to wear a face covering. For those that cannot wear a face covering due to a medical condition, we will offer the following accommodations: use of a Library provided face shield or a curbside appointment.
