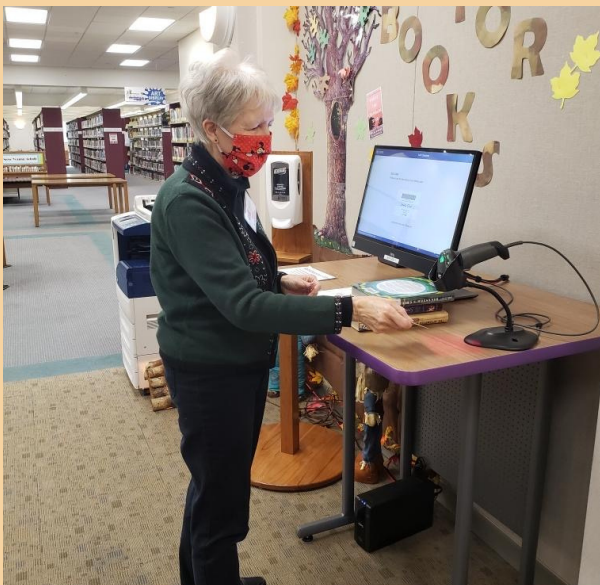
WELCOME PATRONS!
